QUICK TIPS: General Guidelines for Riding a Motorcycle Safely

Be visible:

Remember that motorists often have trouble seeing motorcycles and reacting in time.

Make sure your headlight works and is on day and night.

Use reflective strips or decals on your clothing and on your motorcycle.

Be aware of the blind spots cars and trucks have.

Flash your brake light when you are slowing down and before stopping.

If a motorist doesn't see you, don't be afraid to use your horn.

Dress for safety:

Wear a quality helmet and eye protection.

Wear bright clothing and a light-colored helmet.

Wear leather or other thick, protective clothing.

Choose long sleeves and pants, over-the-ankle boots, and gloves.

Remember – the only thing between you and the road is your protective gear.

Road Captains

Just to let everyone know that as Road Captains we do not make every ride that members take. So, we want to pass on a little information to everyone. Remember before you pull out as a group and start riding down the highway, please take the time to call everyone together and inform them where the ride will be going and the routes that will be used. The leader should ask about the skill level of the members so the leader will know what pace to set on the ride. The leader should make sure all bikes are topped off with fuel and that the members understand the route. Take a few minutes and go over the hand signals so everyone will know what you are doing with your hands. Also advise the other members to pass the signal on back to the other riders. The tail gunner is responsible to make sure that if someone goes off the road for a break down that he stops for support. If the leader and tail gunner have communication with each other that is even better. Be careful and Ride with Pride.
