PRESIDENT'S NOTES:

Report from 2022 Winter MDC meeting. Not sure where the 2023 Winter MDC will be held as of yet. It most likely will be either Rehoboth Beach, Delaware or Wilmington, North Carolina.

Membership 2022 dues have been paid. Cards as of February 11th, 2022 had not arrived at the international office. MDC has dropped chapters and membership in the last few years. As of now we have 55 chapters and 1592 members. There were 14 chapters present at the Winter MDC meeting. There were 27 members at the safety roundtable meeting.

The 2022 International Convention will be in June over in Ireland. The 2023 International Convention will be in Harrisburg, Pa and 2024 will be the 50th Anniversary of the Blue Knights and convention will be in Bangor, Maine.

Now our chapter has to get down to work for our hosting of the Spring MDC. Please send in your registration forms and get your hotel reserved now. Also please sign up for a work detail, we are only asking for a few hours of your time for the weekend. You will still have time to socialize.

2022 Proposal to disband the Board of Governors (proposed by International President D.J. Alvarez) has a lot of members confused as to what is going on. I have sent out the original letter with the proposal from Alvarez to all of you as well as another letter from several of the past international presidents. I have talked with several members from different conferences and they are just as confused as the rest of us here in the MDC. This proposal was not known at the Winter MDC meeting so no one had a chance to discuss this at the conference. After talking with other members there is one thing that most agree with and that is that a few changes could be made with the BOG. Most believe that there should be at least 3 meetings a year not just one. Some suggest maybe a meeting every quarter. Also, if any investigations or appeals come to them, the BOG should have it completed within 60 days. So, there are some ideas out there but most do not think the BOG should be disbanded. BOG has been there since the late 70's.

I know some of our members sent back a vote to agree with the proposal when the original letter went out but have changed their minds after reading the last email letter from the past presidents. I am at the belief that we should keep the BOG and change a few things so they are more efficient and getting things done quicker. This is my opinion.

Moonshine Road Trip

May 19 – 22, 2022; In preparation for the trip I strongly recommend that you watch the NETFLIX movie LAWLESS which is based on a true story of the Bondurant Brothers from Franklin County, Virginia. To this day Franklin County is considered "The Wettest County in the World". Also search the internet on the Bondurant Brothers and Junior Johnson from Wilkes County, North Carolina. Johnson's "moonshine running" lead to the birth of NASCAR. Wilkes County, NC is considered "The Moonshine Capital of the World". Remember the song "Tom Dooley".... he too was from Wilkes County, NC. and was tried, convicted and hanged for murdering Laura Foster. So you can see this is going to be a great ride.

Here is a possible itinerary (not etched in stone):

- Leave Harrison County on May 19th ride through Elkins/Monterey/Staunton and get the Blue Ridge Parkway....this is about 200 miles
- Ride 120+ miles on the Blue Ridge to the Rocky Mount, VA exit and do a brief stop at Rocky Mount the area where the Bondurant Brothers was from. (50 miles)
- Ride another 50 miles to Wilkesboro, NC where Junior Johnson, the Call Family and a few others made and ran their moonshine. Possible overnighter here.
- Visit some of the attractions including the Call Family Distillery and ride some of the moonshine runner roads. End up at the Junior Johnson Distillery in Madison, NC. Maybe (150 miles).
- From there head back north stopping at the Bondurant Brothers Distillery in Chase City, Virginia. (100 miles).
- Head Home on Sunday by riding through Lewisburg, WV. (350 miles)

Note: Not sure where we will overnight.....will leave that up to the group as we ride along. Let me know if you are interested and I'll set up a pre-ride get to gather.
